I give to my dear beloved wife Jane, all my Estate during her life or widowhood, and after her death or widowhood I give my Land to my two sons, James Maddux and Lewis Maddux, and after her death or widowhood I give all the balance of my Estate to be ~~equally~~ divided equally among the whole of my Children.
