the sum of one dollar. Item I give and bequeath
to my daughter Mary Saltensall, having
my property Amy Maria, Hagar Nancy and
Stephen One half of my stock of Hogs the choice
of my horses and the colt My riding chair
and horse cast the whole of my crop now
growing on the plantation the whole of the
provisions now on hand the whole of the
house hold and Kitchen furniture not other-
wise disposed of all of my plantation lands
the whole of my tract of land wherein I
reside to have and to hold her and her heirs
forever. Item I give to my grand daughter
Margaret ~~Goden~~ ^{Troup} County Mill Book 1808-1840 Tunkhaw
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my knotter companion to her forever. Item I give
to my son Harry Gibbons my entire stock of
goats to him forever. Item my wish and
desire is that my daughter Mary Sallentall
be my executors to this my last will and
my Son Harry Gibbons also my Executor
