Wilkinson County, I Anrilla Albritton of
the State and County above written being
very weak & sick in body but of perfect
Mind and Memory Thanks be to God
calling unto mind the Mortality of my
Body and Knowing that it is appointed
for all to die. do make & ordain this my
last Will & testament; That is to say
principally & first of all I give, and
recommend my soul unto the hands of
Almighty God that gave it and my
body I recommend to the earth to be
buried in a decent ~~Christian~~ burial,
Nothing doubting but at the general
Resurrection I shall receive the same
again by the mighty power of God
And as touching such worldly estate
wherewith it has pleased God to bless
me with in this life I give, demise &
dispose of the same in the following

Wish, I give bequeath to my son Wm
Albritton one Bay Horse one two year
old filly one cow & yearling one cow
& calf one yearling and my stock of
sheep & hogs. and one feather bed and
furniture and all my household furniture
and what is coming to me from the
estate if any by him freely to be possessed
of & I do hereby utterly disavow, revoke
and disannul all & every other former
Testaments, wills, legacies, bequests by
me in any wise before named willed
and bequeathed, ratifying & confirming
this & no other to be my last will and
testament in witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand & seal this seventh
day of April in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred & seventeen
