lifetime as aforesaid

Item. I give and bequeath after the
death of my wife above named unto
my Grand children by my Daughter Polly
Hampton all my Estate both real
and personal

(remaining) is to be equally divided among
them share and share alike the same
to them respectively and they heirs for ever
provided nevertheless that my Grand
Daughter Rachel May should not before
the time she will be entitled to receive
the legacy left her as above yet relieved
from the present Husband in some legal
manner (My will and desire is that in
such case my Grandson Benjamin Wade
Hampton name and hold the same and
trust for his sister the said Rachel May
for her use and benefit individually and
to the entire exclusion of her ^{said} Husband
but to deliver over the same or such part
thereof as may remain as soon as she may
be entitled to receive the same according
to the true intent of this proviso.)

Lastly, I hereby nominate constitute and
appoint my Grandson Benjamin Wade
Hampton and my friend James Love
executor to this my Last and testament.
fully vouching all former wills and testa-
ments by me made and ratifying
and confirming the same only this to

be my true last will and testament.
