which parts or shares I here by give and bequeath

Susan Elizabeth Bacon and her heirs forever the
remaining six parts or shares of the said property
of my self and husband I give and bequeath
unto my six other children excluding the said
Susan Elizabeth Bacon to have and to hold forever
I do here by nominate my son Bryan
Allen Sole Executor of this my last will

Estate both Real and personal to my Grandchildren
dread that I have not here to give to my
children and my Will and desire further is that
all my Estate both Real and personal be divided
into three equal Lots or Shares and my Execu-
tors shall set apart by lottery one of said
or Shares to each family of my Grandchildren
and in case any one of my children
die without issue then and in that case the
Lot or Share of my Estate that would have
gone to him shall be equally
divided among the other two families
