half and to Elizabeth Mot one Cow and half

3rd and it is my wish & desire after my Mother's
death that all the rest of my Estate shall be equal-
ly divided between Elbert Duncan Thomas Duncan
and Rebecca Miller

4th I do make appoint and ordain my beloved Brother
Elbert Duncan my whole & sole Executor to this
my last Will and Testament. this 3rd day of May
in the year of our Lord 1830
