I Fleet Pope of the county of Laurens and
State of Georgia being Weak in body but of
sound mind & Memory do make and
publish this my last Will & Testament
in manner & form following - That is
to say in the first place my wish and
desire is that my executor do collect
all the monies due me, sell my horse
to the best advantage & also the tract
of land that lies in Hayette County
of which I own one third hold &
all my just debt paid it sufficient
with my crop of cotton -

Secondly - The balance of my property
after paying all my just debt to be
equally divided between my wife & children
but that it should be kept together for
the support of my wife & children so
long as my executor may think
it advisable or to the interest of all

of this my last will & testament. In
witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand & seal this 17th day of September 1824

signed, sealed & declared by
the above named Fleet Pope
to be his last will & testament
in presence of us who have
hereunto subscribed our names
as witnesses in presence of the
testator
