desirous to settle my worldly affairs
while I have strength and capacity to
do do make & publish this my last
will & testament hereby revoking & making
void all former wills by me at any time
heretofore made, and first & principally
I commit my soul into the hands of
my Creator who gave it & my body to
the earth and as to such worldly estate
whereunto it hath pleased God to instruct
me I dispose of in the following manner
to wit, First I give & bequeath unto my
son in Law I hadrach Duke one dollar
Secondly, I give & bequeath unto my son
in Law Wright Sheffield one dollar
Thirdly, I give unto my grand children
Mary Ann Harrison, Thomas R Harrison
Sealer L Harrison & Hansel W Harrison
parts of tracts lots or parcels of land lying
& being in the county aforesaid situated in
the first district of originally Wilkerson
now Laurens County aforesaid known &
distinguished in the plan of said district
by lot (No 233) number two hundred &
thirty three that part which layeth
north west of the original tract of land
(to wit

the name of Robert's branch adjoining the town of Dublin in said county the original track of land and Franklin street in said Dublin to wit, extending easterly to said Franklin street westwardly to the line of said land northwardly to the said town of Dublin and southwardly to the branch aforesaid containing three acres more or less. Fourthly, I give & bequeath unto my son in law William Leonard the land whereon he now lives adjoining Franklin street and lands of the Town of Dublin aforesaid to extend southwardly to the branch called Robert's branch northwardly to the lands of said Dublin Eastwardly one hundred & fifty four yards from said Franklin street and westwardly to said street it being part of lot or track of land lying & being in the first district originally Milkenora now Laurens County known in the plan of said district by lot (No 233) Number two hundred & thirty three containing twenty acres more or less.

Fifthly, I give & bequeath to my son in law Alfred Thompson the land whereon he now lives it being part of lot track or parcel of land lying & being in the County aforesaid situate in the first district originally Milkenora now Laurens County aforesaid known and distinguished in

part which layeth north east of said
tract of land to wit north west of the
Branch running through said land
generally known by the name of Roberts
and all of said tract that layeth on the
north west of said Branch adjoining
lands already willed by me in this will
testament to Mary A. Harrison, Thomas
R. Harrison, Lealey E. Harrison & Hannah
M. Harrison and the original tracts
of land containing twenty acres more
or less.

Sixthly, I give & bequeath unto my
son Daniel Roberts the ballance of
my estate not otherwise disposed of both
real & personal, choses in action & prop-
erty save one Negro Woman named
Rina which I will bequeath unto
my loving wife Lucy Roberts during
her natural life then to my said son
Daniel Roberts forever.

Seventhly & lastly I will, wish & desire
that Thomas Moon & Nell Ann Moore Esqrs
be my executors of this my last will &
testament. In witness I the said

I have strength so to do, do add the following
as a Codicil or supplement to my last will
& testament, viz. That I do hereby revoke
and make null & void so much of my
last will & testament as conveys or in any
wise gives & bequeaths to my son in law
Oliver Thompson a certain lot track or
parcel of land wherein he has formerly lived
being part of lot track or parcel of land
lying & being in the county aforesaid situated
in the first district originally Wilkinson
now Laurens County aforesaid known &
distinguished in the plan of said district by lot
No 233 number two hundred & thirty three
that part which layeth north east of said
tract of land; to wit north west of the
branch running through said lands known
by the name of Roberts Branch & all of
said tract lying on the north west of
said Branch adjoining lands already given
& willed by me in my last will & testament
to Mary A Harrison, Thomas R Harrison
Leahy G Harrison & Hansel W Harrison
& the original tract of land containing
twenty acres more or less, And I do further
will & bequeath to my son Daniel Roberts
the said lot of land as well described in my
last will & testament as in this codicil lying

Thomas R. Harrison former owner of said land
 acres more or less & killed by me in my
 former will to Alfred Thompson which part
 of said will I do now revoke. I have
 & do hold to said son Daniel the above
 described twenty acres of land to his own
 free use & possession till the first day of
 March eighteen hundred & forty two; after
 which period the above lot or parcel of land
 shall revert to the heirs of my daughter
 Mary Thompson wife of said Alfred
 Thompson to their own use & benefit
 forever & I do hereby revoke all wills or
 parts thereof which shall or may in any
 wise give to said Alfred Thompson any
 right or interest in said land.

Recorded 16th May 1823 -

By the blessing of God being in my right
mind, and weak in body I do make this
my last Will & testament. I do Will and
bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary
2nd my plantation where I do now live on
to have the house hold & kitchen furniture
the crop that that is now growing on
the plantation, the plantation utensils
& my cash. Her sons & Calvin & Sam Gray,
I make all my stock of hogs & what money
I have on hand & all the promissory notes
I have & beef cattle sufficient to support
the family. This property for her to hold
her life time & then to go to be divided
between my three children, my daughter
Rebecka & my son Thomas & my
son Ellis for them to have at her death
I do Will & bequeath unto my daughter
