Kinzred Pella James abez and Edwiy Adams  
worth all my Land Situate lying and being  
in the County of Laurens aforesaid on the  
East side of Little Rocky Creek I do  
the third I also give my Bay Mare and  
Cream Colt two Pided Cows and thin  
Calves one black Cow also two Sows  
and Pigs and six Shotes one horse cart  
all the Flours and Yeer all my all my Pork  
corn and fodder four axes four wedding  
hoes also three fether beds and their furniture  
also all my kitchen furniture After all  
I constitute appoint friend Richard  
Barlow my whole Executor of this my last  
will and testament In witness whereof I have hereunto  
set my hand and seal this 23<sup>rd</sup> day
