

In the name of GOD. Amen. I Abner Anderson of the State
Georgia and County of Laurens, Planter, being of sound and
disposing mind and memory do make and Ordain this my
last will and testament in manner and form following;
Item it is my express will and desire that the whole of my
Estate both real and personally be kept together in the possession
of my wife Mary Anderson until my just debts be duly
paid, Only one waggon and two or three horses and a gun
or two, and such other Articles as she may think proper,
I will and desire may be sold in order to satisfy my just
debts - Item it is my will & desire that my Grand Daughter
Joyce Coursey shall have out of my Estate one Cow & calf
to be delivered up to her at the death of my wife, or when my
youngest son Wade H. Anderson attains to the age of twenty
one years: Also I give to my Son in Law William Coursey
one three year old Steer, to be delivered up to him at the
same time, also I give and bequeath to Daughter Ginny
Barlow one Cow at the same time; also I give and be-
queath to my Daughter Betsey Anderson one Cow, also to
be delivered at the same time; Also I give & bequeath
to my Daughter Polly Wood one Cow at the same time
Item I give and bequeath to my son Abraham Anderson
one square of Land called the back country &
it is my intent & meaning that he shall not dispose of
the same until the death of my wife or my above
mentioned son comes of age - Item I give & bequeath
to my son John Anderson half the bounty of Land
which I possess which was drawn by Isaac Kirkling, not
to be disposed of by him till the time before mentioned
Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary
Purkiss one Cow at the same time. Item I give

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and bequeath to my son west. Anderson the other
half of said bounty of Land which I have above
described & give to my son John; Also I give and
bequeath to Daughter Partina. One but at any time
when convenient, or at any time when my wife may think
proper. Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Sina
Anderson One Bed in like manner. Item I
give and bequeath to my daughter. Natilda
Anderson One Pillow in like manner. Item I give
and bequeath to my son Jefferson One negro boy by the
name of Anne to be given up to him at any time when
my wife may think proper. Item I give & bequeath
to my son Madison. Anderson One negro by the name
of Charles to be given up to him in like manner.
Item I give and bequeath to my son Washington
One negro boy the name of Tom, to be given up
to him in the same manner. Item I give & bequeath
to my son Wade Hamilton Anderson One negro
boy by the name of Joe to be given up to him in
the same manner. Item I give & bequeath all my
bounty of Land lying on Rocky Creek & my fraction
of land lying on Turkey Creek to be equally
divided between my four youngest sons Jefferson
Anderson, Madison. Anderson, Washington. Anderson
and Wade H. Anderson the said Lands to be divided
as above described, when the youngest of my said sons
attains to the age of twenty one years. Item I give
and bequeath to my seven within named daughters
two negro girls One by the name of Ann, and the
other by the name of Elary, and their increase to
be equally divided between myself and daughter &

the death of my wife Mary Anderson, or when my said
youngest son comes to age as before mentioned -

Then I give and bequeath to my three Oldest sons Abram
Anderson, John Anderson and West Anderson two negro
boys one by the name of Jim, and the other by the name of Sam
to be equally divided between them at the same time as
before mentioned - Lastly it is my true intent & mean-
ing that all my Estate both Real and Personal shall be
retained & kept in the possession of my said wife as is
before mentioned, and if there is any thing remaining
that is not mentioned, belonging to my Estate, or may be
in the possession of my said wife at her death, it is my
will and desire, it should be equally divided between all
my said Children as before mentioned. I also nomi-
nate, constitute and appoint my wife Mary An-
derson Executor, And my friends John Hallowell
and Amos Love my Executors of this my Last will
and testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto

-uary, in this year of Our Lord Eighteen hundred
