State of Georgia This is the last will and
Testament of me Jesse Carey of the County
of Laurens & State aforesaid, made this twenty first
day of October in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred & sixteen

First it is my will & desire that my Executors
herein after named pay whatever just debts
there may be against me at the time of
my decease out of my Surplusage property
not otherwise

To my son Vincent Carey I give
Devise & bequeath a certain Negro man Slave
named Peter & fifty dollars in money the said
negro to be delivered within two months & the
money to be paid within Twelve months
after my decease.

To my grand daughter Mary
daughter of

28. I give devise & bequeath the Sum of one hundred & fifty dollars to be paid by my after named Executors at the time she is authorised by Law to Chase her guardian, or at the time of her marriage or coming to the age of Twenty one. To my daughter Ruth wife

of Clement Funnell I give devise & bequeath a certain negro girl Slave named Nanny together with her future Issue & Increase also four Cows & their Calves; the Cows & Calves to be delivered to her husband within four months after my decease.

To my daughter Nanny I give devise & bequeath a certain negro Woman Slave named Sarah with future ~~Issue & Increase~~ also a certain Lumber man or Filly, together with one Bed & furniture & one fourth part of the other Household furniture all to be delivered to her within four months after my decease by my heirs after named Executors.

To my son John Cary

I give bequeath & devise The Tract of Land on which I now reside with all and singular the Rights members & appurtenances thereto belonging To him his heirs Executors or assigns forever also a certain negro man Slave named Tom together with a certain Tract or Lot of Land whereon my son Jesse Cary, now deceased, formerly lived together with all and singular the Rights members & appurtenances thereto belonging to him his heirs Executors or assigns forever.

To my daughter Jane Cary I Give, Devise and bequeath a certain negro Girl Slave named Doll & her Child Linus together with her future issue & increase, also one Bed & furniture together with one fourth part of my house hold furniture all to be delivered to her or her guardian on her making choice thereof according to Law or on her marriage or coming to the age of Twenty one years.

To my daughter Elizabeth Cary I Give devise & bequeath a certain negro Girl Slave named Patt & her Child Pleasant together with their future issue & increase; also one Bed & furniture, together with one fourth part of my House hold furniture; all to be delivered to her or her guardian on her making choice thereof according to Law or on her marriage or coming to the age of Twenty one years.

To my last aforesaid four Children namely my son John & three Daughters Nancy, Jane & Elizabeth I Give & bequeath jointly the following property namely a certain negro man Slave named Juby & Hannah the wife of the said Juby together with all and singular my Stock of Horses Cattle & Hogs & farming utensils of all kinds & descriptions with my Stock of Sheep & Poultry which said last aforesaid bequeathed property is to be & remain

30, in the hands & possession of my said son
John Cary for the Raising & Schooling
& nurturing of my aforesaid three Daughters untill
they respectively come of age & for the pay-
ment of any Debts I may owe at the
time of my decease, & all Debts, dues &
demands that may be owing me with the
Crop that may be then growing at my
decease. it is my will & desire that it
be appropriated in the said manner
& at the coming of age of the last of
my aforesaid named children the aforesaid
last bequeathed property (with the exception
of the last aforesaid Negro Woman
named Hannah who is to belong to
my Brother Alexander Cary untill his decease,
is to be divided equally among my Last aforesaid
four children Share & Share alike

Lastly I do hereby Constitute, Ordain &
appoint my aforesaid named Son John Cary,
Samuel Montgomery & Solomon Hall my
Executors of this my last will & Testament
In Witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and affixed my Seal the day
& year aforesaid

In the name of God Amen, I Thomas Farmer
of the County of Laurens and State of Georgia being
of Sound and disposing mind and memory but calling
to mind the mortality of the Body and knowing
that it is appointed for all men once to die, do
make and ordain this my Last will and Testament
and first of all I recommend my Soul into the
hands of Almighty God, and my body to be buried
at the discretion of my Executors, who I shall
hereafter name - and as touching such worldly property
as it hath pleased God to bless me with in this
life, I give and demise in the following manner,
to wit, my wish and desire is that all my Just
debts be paid & fully discharged.

Item I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Eliza-
beth Farmer my Land and plantation whereon
I now live with all and singular the rights, liberties
and appurtenances therunto belonging to her and her
heirs forever. —

Item I give and bequeath to my brother Joseph
Farmer one dollar to him and his heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to my brother Jesse
Farmer one dollar to him and his heirs forever
