and funeral ~~Expenses~~ charges be first paid
and then all the rest of my Estate to be dis-
posed of in form and manner following
(Item) I give and bequeath to my dear and
well beloved wife Rebecca former all the goods
and Chattels lands and tenements and Stock
of Rinds that she was seized and possessed
with at the time we were married and her
the increase of the said Stock and one fourth
part of the crop I have made this year (I
term) I give and bequeath my Son Amos
former Davis former and my Daughter John
with one lot of land in Thirds District
municipal County of Laurens
to be divided between them

I do hereby give one father bed and his furniture
 and one half my shop tools and the other
 half of my shop tools and one father bed
 and he has now in possession to my
 son David Joiner and to my Daughter Gillah
 Wells her father beds and furniture to her
 and her heirs forever lawfull begetter of
 her body and all the remainder part of
 my Estate both in doors and out doors
 and Stock of all kinds that I am possessed
 with and that money in hand and
 notes to be Equally divided between my
 three children Benett Joiner David
 Joiner and Gillah Wells to them and
 their heirs forever and if my Daughter
 Gillah Wells should die without an
 heir her part of my Estate to return back
 to my sons Benett and David Joiners
 to they and their heirs forever and I do
 hereby constitute and appoint my & s
 sons Benett Joiner and David Joiner my
 Executors to this my last will and test
 ment in witness where of I have hereunto
 set my hand and seal this the twenty seventh
 day of August 1827
