In the name of God Amen I Lucretia Daniel
being weak in body but of sound mind & memory do
make and ordain this my last will & Testament
First I give and bequeath to my son John Daniel
two feather beds Bedstead & furniture and all the
balance of my house hold and kitchen furniture
one negro girl named Sarah about three years
old and all my stock of cattle to him & his heirs
forever
Secondly I give and bequeath unto my son William Da-
niel one feather bed bedstead and furniture - to
him and his heirs forever
Thirdly I give and bequeath unto my son William Daniel
and my Daughter Betsey Brantly one negro woman
named Middy to be equally divided also I give to my
Daughter Betsey Brantly my wearing apparel to them &
their heirs forever
Fourthly I give and bequeath to my three Children
William Daniel John Daniel & Betsey Brantly
all that Lot of Land drawn by me in the last
land Lottery to them and their heirs forever
Fifthly I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint
my two beloved sons John Daniel & William Daniel
Executors of my last will and Testament
