In the name of God Amen I John
McBane of the County of Laurens being of sound
Mind and Memory do make and ordain this
my last Will and Testament 1st & by will
And desire is that all my just debts be paid
And fully discharged I Do Give and bequeath
my beloved wife Mary McBane during her
Natural lifetime or until my youngest Child
comes of age all my Estate (after the pay-
ment of my debts) both real and personal
to enable her to raise and School my Children
And whatever may remain of my property or the
proceeds thereof at the death of my said wife
or at my youngest Childs coming of age my wish
And desire is that the same be equally divided
among such of them as may then be alive including
my wife should the division happen in her life-
time Lastly I hereby nominate constitute and
appoint my beloved wife Mary McBane
Sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testa-
ment - hereby revoking all former Wills and
Testaments by me made and ratifying
and confirming this only to be my last Will
and Testament - In Testimony whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and affixed
my Seal this thirty first day of December in
the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and

And discharge all my just debts And what of
worldly Estate may remain after paying my
debts I give bequeath and dispose of in the
following manner to wit

Item My will and desire is that the whole
of my Estate after the payment of my debts
be equally divided between my daughters
