In the name of God Amen I John
M^o Bone of the County of Laurens being of sound
Mind and memory do make and ordain this
my last Will And Testament 1st day aforesaid
And desire is that all my just debts be paid
And Geary be charged on my Estate And bequeath
My beloved wife Ellangell^e Bone during her
natural lifetime or until my youngest Child
comes of age all my Estate (After payment
of my debts) both real and Personal
to enable her to raine and School my Children
And whatever may remain of my Property or the
proceeds thereof at the death of my said wife
or at my youngest Childs coming of age my wife
and desire is that the same be equably divided
among such of them as may then be alive including
my wife should the division happen in her life
time Lastly I hereby Name and appoint
and appoint my beloved wife Ellangell^e Bone
the Executrix of this my last Will And Testa-
ment - hereby revoking all former Wills and
Testaments by me made and ratifying
and confirming this only to be my last Will
And Testament - In testimony whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and affixed

Item My will and desire is that the whole
of my Estate after the payment of my debts
be equally divided between my beloved
friend William D. Elkmire and Stephen James
