this my last will And Testament that is to say  
First I give my soul to almighty God  
who gave it to me and body I resign to the  
earth to be buried in a decent Christian like  
Manner - Secondly Ie command And desire  
that my Executors hereinafter named Pay off  
And discharge all my just debts And what of  
Worldly Estate may remain after Paying <sup>out of</sup> my  
debts I give at my death and dispose of in the  
following manner to wit

Item My will and desire is that the whole  
of my Estate after the Payment of my debts  
be legally divided between my berefted  
friend William D. Elkins My stepson from

Todd And my Niece Elizabeth Morgan  
My laws to them and their heirs respectively  
forever - to be managed and arranged in  
the following manner my Executors to sell so  
much of my Personal Property at their discretion  
as may be sufficient to pay all my debt  
My Lot in the Town of Dublin to be sold  
by them at Public Sale giving legal notice  
on a credit of three months and the balance  
of my Personal Property in such manner as  
they may deem most advisable and the  
balance thus raised after the payment  
of my debt together with what my said  
Executors may be able to collect of debt now  
due and owing to me to be divided as above  
Mentioned & Lastly I hereby nominate  
Captain and appoint my trusty friends  
William D. Allgood and Doctor Thomas  
Moore Executors to this my last Will and  
Testament hereby revoking all wills and  
Testaments by me made ratifying and  
Confirming this to be my true last Will  
And Testament On witness whereof I  
have hereunto set my hand and affixed  
my seal this fifth day of December in  
the year of our Lord 1819
