In the name of God Amen I John Todd
of the State of Georgia and County of Laurens
being of Sound mind And memory do make
this my last will And Testament that is
I say first I give my soul to almighty God
who gave it to me and body I give to the
earth to be buried in a decent Christian like
Manner - Secondly I recommend And desire
that my Executors hereinafter named pay off
And discharge all my just debts And what of
worldly Estate may remain after paying my
debts I give hereath and dispose of in the
following manner to wit

Item My will and desire is that the whole
of my Estate after the payment of my debts
be equally divided between my daughters
Gracie William D. Elgers My Stephen

Todd And my heirs Elizabeth Morgan
the same to them and their heirs respectively
forever - To be managed and arranged in
the following manner my Executors to sell so
much of my Personal Property at their discretion
as may be sufficient to pay all my debts
My Lot in the Town of Dublin to be sold
by them at Public Sale giving legal notice
on a credit of Twelve months And the balance
of my Personal Property in such manner as
they may deem most advisable and the
balance then raised after the pay ment
of my debt together with what my Said
Executors may be able to collect I do now
due and owing to me to be divided as above
mentioned & Lastly I hereby nominate
constitute and appoint my trusty friends
William D. Higgins And Doctor Thomas
Moore Executors to this my last will and
Testament hereby revoking all ^{former} wills and
Testaments by me made ratifying and
confirming this to be my true last will
and Testament In witness whereof I
have here unto set my hand And affixed
my seal this fifth day of December in
the year of our Lord 1817
