my last Will and testament.

Imprimis. My soul I commend to God
who gave it. My body to its kindred dust
Item. My Will and desire is that my
beloved Wife Eliza Bacon have, possess
and enjoy forever & the heirs of her body
the following property viz. my horses, hogs
goats, stock of all kinds whatsoever, also
Carriages & furniture of all descriptions also
the following named negroes and their
future increase to wit, Nanny, Tom, Booby,
Lony, Lizy, Jimmy, Leah, Grace, Phillis Jam
and Mary ^{ten or 40 per} also three tracts of land on
Big Canuchee containing six hundred
fifty acres —

Item. I give and bequeath to my two
children Edmund & Sarah Bacon the
following named negroes viz. Sawney,
Aaron, Sue, Liddia, Rose, Phillis, Leno,
Stephen, Bill, Israel, Katy, Little Liddia,
Little Venus, Hercules and little Sue, and
should they die without issue to my beloved
Wife & the heirs of her body forever.

And lastly, as to the residue and remainder
of my property both real and personal not
herein bequeathed I will and desire to go to
and vest in my wife Eliza Bacon to her
& her heirs forever and I do hereby constitute
my said wife my sole executrix.

her eighteen hundred & twenty two.
