I Joseph Livingstone of the State of Georgia
and County of Laurens do make & declare
this my last Will & testament in manner
following -

First I resign my soul into the hands
of Almighty God hoping & believing in a
remission of my sins by the merits and
mediation of Jesus Christ and my body
I commit to the earth to be buried at the
discretion of my friends to be buried after

Livingston for and during her Widowhood
or Natural life, all the land & premises
whereon I now live containing two hundred
thirty seven acres be there more or less
which is in said state & county adjoining
the land of Jones, Martin, William
Calhoun & John Livingston on the
waters of Goose Creek & also ten
negroes, namely Peter, Junius, Eliza
Will, Ezekiel, Joe, Sylvia, Phillis,
Frank & Nellie & their increase, all the
stock of Horses, Cattle, Dogs & hogs & also
all the house hold & kitchen furniture
& plantation tools of every kind, quality
& description whatsoever belonging or
composing any part of my estate,
only such as might be expended in
for the education of all my children
and after the death of my wife I
leave the whole of my estate of every
kind nature or quality whatsoever to
be equally distributed or divided between
my children, namely, Henry Livingston,
William Livingston, Eliza Livingston,
Pancy Livingston, Mary Livingston &
Sarah Livingston or them that may
be living at such time -
