I Mark Philips of the County of Laurens and State of Georgia, being very sick and weak in body, but of perfect mind & memory thanks be given unto God, Calling unto mind the Mortality of my body, and knowing that it is appointed for all men Once to die, do make and Ordain this my Last will and Testament, that it to say, principally and first of all, I give and recommend my soul unto the hands of a Almighty God that gave it, and my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in decent Christian burial at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but that at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God, and touching such worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life, I give devise and dispose of the same in the following manner and form. First, I give and bequeath to my beloved son H. Harrington & Philips the tract & Lot of Land whereon my dwelling house stands, known by the number two hundred and three.

Secondly, I give and bequeath to my beloved son David Dawick Philips, that tract & Lot of Land, lying in Pulaski County, known by the number of one hundred & eighty seven granted to Dital. Revy. Thirdly, I give and bequeath to my beloved Daughter Claracy Philips the negroe girl named Charlot. Fourthly, I give and bequeath to my beloved son Joel Tharod Philips, one negroe man named Bot. Fifthly and lastly, I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Diza Philips five Choys Cows and Calves, and the little mare, and two Sows & pigs and all my household and kitchen furniture and the gear, also Corn and pork sufficient to support the family the ensuing year at the discretion of my Executors. And all the rest of my estate

I leave to be sold, and after discharging my just debts, the  
rest of the money up any, to be equally divided between my  
four Children above named - I likewise constitute, make  
and Ordain my beloved brothers Gabriel Philips & Burrell  
Philips the sole Executors of this my Last will and Testament  
and do hereby utterly disallow, revoke and disannul all & every  
other former testament, Wills, legacies, bequests and Creations  
by me in any ways before named, willed & bequeathed, ratify-  
ing and confirming this and no other to be my Last will  
and testament - In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my  
hand & seal this seventh day of December in the year  
our Lord eighteen hundred and fourteen.
