Laurens County } of Body, but of sound and perfect mind &
Memory, blessed be God, do this sixteenth day
of August, in the year of our lord one thousand
eight hundred & twenty make & ordain this
my last will & testament, in manner and
form following to wit.

1st I give & bequeath to my son Thomas P. Barlow
one negro Boy, Jerry, two bed & furniture,
two cows & calves, the whole of my stock of
hogs, two horses, one breeding Pig my crop of
all kind, my household & kitchen furniture
and all the rest of my estate to be held
& enjoyed by him & his heirs forever.

2nd I do hereby constitute & appoint my friend
Archibald Griffin Executor to this my last will
& testament. In Witness Whereof I have hereunto
set my hand & seal this day & date above written
