four hundred & fifteen acres of land more
or less whereon I own line purchased at
the sale of Samuel Beatty dec:-

I give unto my grand son James M.
Vickus one young bond slave two
years old

I give unto my grand daughter Arline
Beaty one bed & furniture -

I give unto my grand daughter Mary
Beaty Vickers one horse when nine years
old & one side saddle -

My Will is that lot No 147 in the 6th
district formerly Wilkenson now Montgomery
county be sold, also lot No 23. 15 district.
Houston county drawn by myself, also
one mare 6 years old & one 2 years old
stud colt be sold to the best advantage
~~and~~ all my just debt be paid out of
the proceeds of said sales & the balance of
what money that may be raised by said
sales over & above paying my just debts
I give to my two grand children James &
Vickers & Mary Beaty Vickers -

My Will I desire is that all the property
that I may die possessed of not specially
disposed of in the above foregoing part of
my Will be given to my two grand chil-
dren James & Vickers & Mary Beaty
Vickers & I do hereby appoint George
Linder & William Bawley executors to
this my last Will & testament hereby
revoking all Wills heretofore made by me
do declare this to be my last Will and
Testament - This 4th day of April 1824

after paying all my just debt to be
equally divided between my wife & children
but that it should be kept together for
the support of my wife & children so
long as my executor may think
it advisable or to the interest of all
