In the name of God Amen.

I Owen W. Young of the County of Laurens
and State of Georgia being a law state
of health tho of perfect mind and memo-
ry do after recommending my soul to
God make and ordain this my last
will and testament

In the first place my will and desire is
that my debts be paid by such ways and
means as my Executors whom I shall
hereafter name shall think most advis-
able for the interest of my estate

Secondly I do hereby order and desire that
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after my death
together and be managed to the best advan-
tage for the support of my wife and chil-
dren untill my youngest child becomes of
age then to be equally divided between
my wife and children share and share
alike. Tho if my wife should Marry before
that period and it should be her wish
to have her part of the estate then and
in that case my Executors will sett off
to her her distributive share also as
the Children becomes of age and wishes
to have their share then my Executors
will also sett off to them their distributive
shares. Lastly I do hereby appoint my
two trusty and worthy friends Edward
H George and Benjamin W Hampton
my Executors. In Witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand & seal this 22 day
of July 1826
