me existence.

2nd I will & desire that all my just
debts be paid out of what I may be
possessed of when I die.

3rd I give will & bequeath unto my son
James A. Newman all of my right title, &
claim to a certain tract or parcel of land
lying in the county of Early in said
State in the eighteenth district of said county
of Early number three hundred & seventy nine
which I drew in the last land lottery of
this State also one feather bed & furniture.

4th And the balance of all that I now
possess I give & bequeath unto my son-in-law
Breckin Bell McLeod & his heirs forever.

5th I wish will & desire that the said
James A. Newman & the said Breckin
McLeod by my executor of my said

& of Body, but of sound and perfect mind &
Memory, blessed be God, do this sixteenth day
of August, in the year of our lord one thousand
eight hundred & twenty make & ordain this
my last will & testament, in manner and
form following to wit.

1st I give & bequeath to my son Thomas P. do
one negro Boy Jerry, two bed & furniture,
two cows & calves, the whole of my stock of
hays, two horses, one riding pig my crop of
all kind, my household & kitchen furniture
and all the rest of my estate to be held
& enjoyed by him & his heirs forever.

2nd I do hereby constitute & appoint my friend
Archibald Griffin Executor to this my last will
& testament. In Witness Whereof I have hereunto
set my hand & Seal this day & date above written
