brown Color no mark I give to the same Grand
Daughter Lucinda One feather Bed & Clothing
Secondly I give & bequeath to my Grand Daughter
Maryann Vickey One red & white Cow
I give to my son Edward Moon thirty Dollars
I give to my son Sewey Elliott One hundred
Dollars. I give to my Daughter Mary Sixty
Eighty five Dollars Cabbages & Chest I give
to my Daughter Biddy Finay Eighty five Dollars
My will & desire is that all the property
above named which I have bequeathed to the
above named Children to remain in the pos-
sion and for the use of my Daughter Mary
Sixty Eighty five Dollars until the grand Children all com-
e of age or marry them to be delivered over
to them according to the above bequest it is
further my desire that the heirs who are now
grown shall pay all expenses relating to
the estate above bequeathed in proportion to
their shares by me above bequeathed

I nominate & appoint Will Munroe of
Laurens County executor of this my Last
Will & Testament hereby reciting all other
& former Wills

to die & wishing to point out the order & manner
for the distribution of what property it has pleased
God to bless me with do make & ordain this
my last will & testament First I wish all my
just debts if I should have any unpaid at
my death paid out of the sale of property hereafter
named. Item I give to my son Henry Pullen & my
large family Bible
Item I give unto my son Thomas Pullen four hun-
dred Acres of Land more or less including
the plantation whereon I now reside Also one Negro
man named Jack & one volume of books com-
mentary
Item I give unto my son Moses Pullen two
hundred Acres of Land now in his possession
also one negro man named John & all
my guns & accoutrements & some volume
of the Bible & some other things I give unto
