The last Will and Testament
of Thomas Montford.

I Thomas Montford of the County of
Laurens and State of Georgia being in

of human life do make this my last will and testament laying aside and making void all others do will & desire that my property shall be disposed of in the following manner viz.

I lend to my wife Sarah Moutford during her natural life or widowhood the following property, the tract of land whereon I now live with all its appurtenances also one feather bed, bedstead and furniture my two sored mares, five cows & calves, chairs, tables & kitchen furniture with the whole of my corn and fodder & stock of hogs.

2^d In case of the marriage or death of my wife I then bequeath my estate as follows.

1st I give & bequeath to my two sons Samuel Whitfield & Edmund Moutford my land to be equally divided between them, to them & their heirs forever.

2^d I give unto my daughter Elizabeth Whitfield an equal share with my two sons above mentioned in all the rest of my estate to her & her heirs forever.

3^d It is my will & desire that my two sons Samuel & Edmund be bound to pay to my daughter Elizabeth the sum of fifty dollars each as a compensation for her share in the said land to be paid to her by them & their heirs forever.

It is my desire that my executors
shall sell my boy man, and one feather
bed & furniture and such cattle as are not
disposed of in this testament for the benefit
of my three children aforementioned.

And lastly, I do appoint my friend
Simcon Collington my sole executor to man-
age & carry into effect this my last will
& testament. In witness I subscribe my hand
this 18th day of March 1821.
