God to bless me with do make & ordain this
my last will & testament First I wish all my
just debts if I should have any unpaid at
my death paid out of the sale of property hereafter
named. Item I give to my son Henry Pullen (my
large family Bible
Item I give unto my son Thomas Pullen four teen
- hundred Acres of Land more or less including
the plantation whereon I now reside Also one Negro
man named Jack & one volume of Cokes com-
mentary
Item I give unto my son Moses Pullen two
hundred Acres of Land now in his possession
also one negro man named John & all
my guns & one volume of Bibles & some volume
of Cokes commentary I give unto

to be raised out of the sales of property hereafter
appropriated.

Then I give unto my Daughter Margaret Nason
One negro man named Jack commonly called
Bonas.

Then I give unto my Daughter Mary Pullen
One hundred & forty four acres of Land on
Big Creek bounded by Charles Mousman
& Simon Ellingtons Land. also one negro
woman named Amy & young sonel. Mare
called Moll & six Cows & calves & one
Bed & ~~the Bed~~ with the furniture thereto
belonging & one other Bed she is making
Vine hunk & ten pair of Geese & one flock
of hens.

Then the balance of my books not here before
disposed of I wish to be equally divided between
my Daughters Phoebe Williams Margaret Nason
& Mary Pullen.

Then I give unto my step son Lewis Linder
One negro man named Jans and one negro
woman named woman named Wapnah.

Then I give unto my step son George Linder
One negro man named Jans commonly called
Jim. Then I give unto my step sons Lewis &
George Linder all the property not herein
mentioned that belonged to their mother
at the time of our better marriage. My
will & desire is that the balance of my
Property not specially disposed of be
sold in order to pay my just debts and
the cash legacy and what remains to be
equally divided between my sons Thomas
Pullen Henry Pullen Moll Pullen & my
step son Lewis Linder & my son William Pullen
one sixth part

it can be done with convenience & propriety
at the discretion of my executor hereafter to
be named and I do hereby appoint Henry
Pallin & George Linde my executors to this
my last will & testament & hereby Revok-
ing all will heretofore made by me
do declare this to be my last will and
testament In witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand & seal this 30th day of Dec-
