tract or parcel of Land whereon I reside, at this time known as the north half of Lot No. Thirty seven, in the Fifteenth District, of Lee County, containing One Hundred and a fourth acres, more or less, with full power to possess and retain said Land, or to sell and dispose of the same, and use the Money arising from said sale during her natural lifetime or widow-hood, and after her death or marriage said money or its equivalent to be divided equally among my Lawful heirs, provided however if sale be made by the said Sarah, and it is to be a Bona fide sale, and her deed to pass all the rights that I have in said Land, & premises in fee simple forever, I also further give and bequeath said Sarah One Negro woman named Sarah, and her increase, and all my other personal property during the term of her natural life or widow-hood, after her death or marriage to be equally divided among my Lawful heirs. I likewise I make & constitute my Father-in-Law Eli Moehman to be Executor of this my Last will and Testament, hereby revoking all former Wills by me made, In witnesses whereof I have hereby subscribed my name and affixed my seal, this the Second day of May One Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty Two, and in the presence of us,
