

Will of Eason Dixon. -

Georgia } I know all men by these presents:
 Lee County } That, E. Eason Dixon of the aforesaid State and
 County, having enlisted in the Army of the
 Confederate States of America for a term of three
 years, and knowing the uncertainty of a
 soldier's life, do by these presents, give to my
 beloved mother Nancy Dixon all that I possess,
 to have and to hold during her natural life,
 if I should die before my term of enlistment in
 the service of the Confederate States shall expire.
 The property which I now bequeath and
 give to my Mother, consists mainly of negroes,
 all of our family whose names respectively, -
 Netty, Dallas, Hulba, Seely, Mace, Edie and
 Hanson, after the death of my mother, this
 property I wish to be divided or disposed of
 according to the Will of my father, Moses
 B. Dixon.

 who signed the same, sworn to and subscribed
