

Will of Ellen A. Green.

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Georgia, B. J. Ellen A. Green, being of sound and disposing
Lee County, Georgia, mind and memory, and well knowing the
instability and uncertainty of human life do
hereby make, ordain and establish this my Last
Will and Testament, hereby revoking all others
heretofore made by me: —

Item 1st I desire that my body be buried in a Christian
manner, and all my just debts be paid.

Item 2nd, I will and bequeath to my two children William
N. Green and Jesse E. Green, and to Deborah F.
Green, the child of my deceased husband by a
former marriage all the property and effects
of every kind including my life Insurance
Policy, and the money that will be paid there-
on to be directed as follows: The said Jesse
E. and William N. Green, shall have and be entitled
to One Thousand Dollars each, more than the said
Deborah, and Lee County Wills
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said Jesse E. and William
N. Green shall have the said One Thousand Dollars
each, the remainder to be equally divided
between the said William N. Jesse E. & Deborah F.

Item 3rd It is my Will and desire that if either, the
said William N. J. E., or D. F., should die without
child or children, living at the time of their
death, the property herein devised to said
deceased shall be distributed equally between
the survivor or distributed between the children
of each, one that may have died leaving child or
children taking the parents share. —
