No. One hundred and thirty-five, - (\$35)

Item Fourth, I give and bequeath to my son, Charley A. Young, my

daughter W.H. Young, my daughter Alice M. Young, and
my daughter Louisa J. Young, Lot of Land No. One hundred
and thirty-five (\$35) in the 16th District of Lee County,
it being my ~~1854-189~~ lot of land. Except the Twenty-five

the said Twenty-five Acres I also give to the said Charley
A. Young, John H. Young, Martha C. Home, W.H. Young
& Alice M. Young or Louisa J. Young, after the death or
