Georgia, - I, John J. Young of said County, being of sound
 Lee County, Mind and disposing Memory desire to make my
 Last will and Testament; -

Item the 1st, I will and desire that after death that my body be
 buried in a Christian like manner and in accordance
 with my wishes, -

Item Second, I will & desire that all my just debts be paid
 by my Executor, here in-after named Appointed,

Item Third, I give and bequeath to my wife, Mary A. Young, during
 her natural life or during her widowhood Twenty-five
 Acres of Land in the south west corner of Lot of Land
 No. One hundred and thirty-five. - (135)

Item Fourth, I give and bequeath to my son, Charley A. Young, my
 son John A. Young, & my daughter, Martha C. Home, my
 daughter W. H. Young, my daughter Alice M. Young, and
 my daughter Louisa J. Young, Lot of Land No. One hundred
 and thirty-five (135) in the 16th district of Lee County,

 Acres give to my son Charley A. Young for life or widowhood,
 the said Twenty-five Acres I then give to the said Charley
 A. Young, John A. Young, Martha C. Home, W. H. Young,
 Alice M. Young & Louisa J. Young, after the death or
 marriage of my wife, -

Item Fifth, I give and bequeath to my daughter Lealie J. Young &
 my son William M. Young, & my daughter Leanie Young,
 North-half of Lot of Land No. One hundred and thirty-
 Nine. (139) in the 16th district of said County, and known
 as my 'Herrin place', in said County, -

Item Sixth, I give and bequeath to my son Charley A. Young,
 my son John A. Young, and my son William M. Young
 & my daughters, Martha C. Home, W. H. Young, Alice

 Carrie Young, all of my personal property, including
 stock, of all kind, wagons, Buggies, Farming imple-
