Butts, before her death, which occurred on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of October 1883, before her death and in perfect possession of her mental faculties, as appeared to us, said Julia F. Butts, called on the by-standers, and upon the undersigned especially, and in particular to remember us, to take notice of what she was about to say. When she said, she desired to make her Will, that she soon must die, and did not have time to reduce the will to writing, that she had just been notified by her doctor, that she must die, and that soon she wished us to understand that her will and desire was, that all of her Estate, both Real & personal, should be divided between her Children, Wick Butts, Missie E. Butts, and that Wick Butts have her Gold-Watch, and that Missie E. Butts have her Watch-chain, and that all of her property, Real and Personal, be kept together, and that her husband J. F. Butts, is to be her Executor, and to keep the property together, and run the same as he did before the death of the said Julia F. Butts, and she requested that J. F.
