County of Dougherty & to my Niece Mary Ann  
Taylor, wife of Thomas R. Taylor, of the County of  
Dougherty to be equally divided between them, share & share alike.  
Item 3<sup>rd</sup>. I do hereby appoint the said George W. Mayes  
and the said Thomas R. Taylor, Executors of this my  
Last Will and Testament. I do witness whereof I,  
the said Ardilla Woolbright, to this my Last will &  
Testament have set my Hand and Seal, this the 21<sup>st</sup>  
day of February 1879.

Georgia I, A. Sanders of said State and County, being in County of said mind and disposing memory, do make this my Last Will and Testament, —
