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In the name of God Amen, I Antomas
Baker of the State of Georgia County of Liberty Plantation
of sound mind & memory do make & Ordain this my last will
& Testament — *Impulsius* — It is my will that all my last
debts be paid out of my Estate, which if thought best by my last
will be kept together until it is done — *Item* I One half of
the tract of land whereon I now live belongs to my Daughter
Jean — the other half of which I give with her together
with confirming to her the one half of the Negroes that fell
to us from the Estate of Jean Robt & Robert & Baillie, that
is to say, the Negroes that was secured or made over to her
by the Mother's Marriage Settlement —
Item I give to my wife Sarah Baker the dower following
namely, Vingt Pils, Andrew Harry, Sandy, Carter, Vilot, Sam,
Charlotte, Dick, Biss, Little Wolf, Cairn & Old Elly with
their issue to her & her heirs for ever — *Item* I give &
bequeath to my son Antomas the whole of the Remains
of my Negroes with their ~~children~~ *issue* —
Item I give unto my wife Sarah all of my household
Furniture, bedding, horses & Riding Chaise — *Item*
about on third of the Cattle I possess belongs to my Daughter
Jean, the other two thirds I leave to be equally divided
between my wife & Son — *Item* — It is my will that
my wife Sarah shall live on the Plantation where I now
Reside have free use of the buildings & plant the land
together with my other heirs during her widowhood —
Item — It is my desire that my part of a tract of Land
on South Newport the other part belongs to Rich Kewok
my Lots in the Town of Brunswick, my part of the Lots
in Sundry that belonged to the Estate of Robert &
Baillie, also my part of the tract of Land on Broad
River belonging to said Estate be all to the use
& advantage to pay of my Debts —
Item I give & bequeath to my wife the Stock of Sheep
together with the Stock of Hogs —
Item — I give to my Brother William my Silver mounted
Gun Shot pouch & all of my wearing Apparels
Item It is my desire that the Remains part of

of the Money due me by Roger, P. Saunders as
Bonds, be laid out to buy Negroes for my Daughter
Jean, the property for which it was sold being con-
sidered Robert C. Baillies Estate, one half of course was
her right agreeable to the marriage Settlement be-
fore mentioned — And lastly — I do appoint my
Brother William Jean Baker, my friends John
Mitchell Junr and Charles Irvine executors of my
beloved Wife Sarah Baker Executrix to this my
last will & Testament, Disannulling all other Wills heretofore
made by me — Witness my Hand & Seal this Fifth Day of
April one thousand Seven hundred & Ninety two,

Jons, Sarah, Joseph, William Ball, Sampson Edward
Ball, Susannah Quarterman, & Robert Quarterman
One Shilling each, to be paid them when of Age.
I Give the Remainder of my Estate, Real, & Personal

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
