

In the Name of God Amen. I, Elizabeth Powell, widow of
Jacob Powell late of Liberty County, Georgia, deceased; being married
in Health but of sound and perfect mind and memory, reflecting on
the uncertainty of the duration of Human life, do make and
ordain this my last Will and Testament, that is to say, principally
and first, I recommend my soul into the hands of God that gave it,
bequeathing his gracious acceptance thereof, and my Body to
the Ground from whence it came, at the direction of my
Executors herein after named. And as touching my worldly
Estate, I give and dispose of in manner following that is to
say, I give unto my daughter Ann Elizabeth Irvine, wife
of Doctor John Irvine, a mourning Ring and my full suit of
Mourning by me. Item, I give and bequeath all and
singular the Estate Real and Personal that I am in any
wise entitled unto, from, or in the Estate of my said deceased
Husband, unto Charles Irvine, my Grandson, Artemus Baker,
who married my Grand daughter Euphemia Davilier, and
James Bullock, who married unto Ann Irvine my Grand
daughter, and Daughter to Doctor John Irvine aforesaid, to
them and their Heirs, share and share alike.
Item, I give and bequeath my Tract of Land, adjoining
Lands of Roger P. Samuels on Newport Liberty County
aforesaid, containing five hundred Acres be the same more
or less, unto my said Executors in Trust, to and for the
following purpose and Intent, that is to say, to be disposed
of when ever it will bring or sell for three hundred dollars per
Acre, and untill the same will sell for that price, to
rent or hire it out to the best advantage, and the Monies
arising therefrom, in either case, to be laid out in prime
Young Negroes, to be improved in the best manner for
the benefit of my Estate, and the same to be divided into
four parts and distributed in the manner following, viz.

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one fourth part of the money or Negroes arising from the sale or hire of the said Tract of Five hundred Acres aforesaid, unto Ann Darling Irvine and any Children of Charles Irvine aforesaid and Elizabeth his wife; One other fourth part of the money or Negroes arising from the sale or hire of said Tract of Land unto Jean Euphemia Darling Baker, Daughter of Artemas Baker and Euphemia Baker, but in case of her death under the age of Eighteen Years, or day of Marriage, such her one fourth part of said Estate, to go to the Child or Children of Charles and Elizabeth Irvine aforesaid. One other fourth part of the money or Negroes, arising from the sale or hire of said Tract of Land unto Alexander Irvine, Son of John and Ann Elizabeth Irvine to be in support of his Education. And one other, and last, equal ^{fourth} part of the money or Negroes arising from the sale or hire of said Tract of Land as aforesaid, unto Eliza Irvine, Daughter of Ann Elizabeth Irvine aforesaid, but if she should die under the age of eighteen Years, or day of Marriage, then such her one fourth part, to be equally divided between the Children of Doctor John Irvine aforesaid & Ann Elizabeth his wife except Alexander aforesaid and the Child or Children of Irvine and Ann Bullock aforesaid. Now, it is my will and desire, and I do hereby give and bequeath all my right title and Interest in, to, and of a certain Tract of Land or more in North Carolina, being called Benjamin Steeds Land, now part of the Estate of my said deceased Husband Josiah Powell deceased, unto Charles Irvine, Artemas Baker and James Bullock herein already named, their Heirs and Assigns. Lastly, I do hereby nominate and appoint Charles Irvine, Artemas Baker, James Bullock and John Graves Executors of this my last will and Testament, hereby
