In the Name of God Amen
 I Hugh Bennett of Liberty County and State aforesaid, being
 weak in Body, but of perfect mind and memory, and calling
 to mind the Mortality of my Body, do make and Order this to be
 my last will and Testament in manner and form following,
 that is to say, first committing my soul into the hands of
 God my faithful Creator and glorious Redeemer, and my Body
 to the Dust to be buried at the discretion of my Executors,
 nothing doubting, but I shall receive the same at the Resurrec-
 tion. I Will that all my Lawful Debts and Funeral
 charges be paid. I Give and bequeath unto my loving
 Wife Rebekah Bennett, one third of all my Estate both Real
 and Personal, she to have and enjoy the same during her
 Vigorous at the Appraisalment, to her, her Heirs and assigns forever
 I Give and bequeath unto my Niece Mary Fleming and
 Nephew William Fleming the remaining two thirds of
 my Estate, to be equally divided between them, and to be

In the Year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and ninety
I Robert Sollett of Liberty County and State of Georgia
Planter being weak in Body, but of perfect and disposing
Mind and Memory, calling to mind the Mortality of
my Body, do make and Ordain this my last will and
Testament in manner following. Viz. all my Real
Estate, together with my four Riding Horses, the
Hambler, blue skin, Dove and Jack of Diamonds, and
all my Stock of Hogs and Goats must be sold in
Order to pay my Debts, as far as the Money arising
therefrom will go. My Will is that all my Slaves
except Milly and Muggs shall be left in the Care of
Mr. Simon Fraser, allowing him full power to
Improve my Estate for the Benefit of my Son.
