Ben Lastly I do nominate constitute and appoint Mr. Joseph Auster

Second to my nephew Master West, I leave and bequeath all that tract of land known by the name of Green, comprising the purchases made of Mr McCoker, Dawson Street Alexander McIver all that Island in the State aforesaid known by the Name of West Island to him and his heirs forever. - Third, I leave and bequeath to my daughter Anna Rogers the house now two lots No 11 & 12 now occupied by me to her and her assigns forever. Fourth - To my Grand daughter Elizabeth C. McIver I leave and bequeath a bay black Steamer to her and her heirs forever.
