Georgia - In the name of God Amen I Sarah Ann Auster of Liberty County being of perfect mind and memory, calling to mind the mortality of my body make and Ordain this my last will & testament (viz) I recommend my body the Earth to be buried in a decent manner & my Soul into the hands of God that gave it, Humbly beseeching him to receive it through the Infinite Merits of Jesus Christ. - I then give & bequeath unto my Son Charles James Auster, all of the hereafter named Negroes with all the profits arising from them, under the contract of his Father Mr. Joseph Auster, viz he dies before he arrives, to the age of twenty one years then after the death of my husband Mr. Joseph Auster the hereafter named Negroes shall, return to the heirs of my Father James Auster & remain sole owners of my husband's estate the profits arising from them, at his own free will and disposal viz: Henry, Delany, John, Lewis, & Abel. Billy, Ned, Titus, Cyran Chester, Jim, & Billy. Bin Lastly I do nominate constitute and appoint Mr. Joseph Auster Mr. John Burnette & Mr. Samuel Burnet my Executors and do hereby certify this to be my last will & testament. In the Name of God Amen, The last will and Testament of Elizabeth Munroe of Sunbury in the State of Georgia, Widow, made and executed at Sunbury, this fourth day of November, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seven - First I leave and bequeath at my decess to my Grand Children Barbara Harriette McIVER, Alexander MacIVER and Euphemia MacIVER all the Negroes now in my possession together with the future increase of to them and their heirs forever except the wench Rensh, which I leave to my Grand daughter Barbara Harriette McIVER; and the wench Tona, which I leave to my daughter Mrs Anna Rogers, their heirs and assigns forever. Second to my daughter Mrs Anna Rogers, their heirs and assigns forever, I leave and bequeath all that tract of land known by the name of Liberty, comprising the purchases made of Mr McCoker, Dawson & Dick Alexander & also all that land in the State of Georgia known by the name of West Island as to him and his heirs forever. - Third, I leave and bequeath to my daughter Anna Rogers the house now two lots No 11 & 12 now occupied by me to her & her assigns forever. Fourth - I my Grand daughter Elizabeth C. H. & I leave and bequeath a bay black steamer to her and her heirs forever. Fifth - I leave and bequeath to my daughter Anna Rogers, to my daughter Anne & to my daughter Barbara H. McIVER all my household furniture
