First I recommend my soul to almighty God who gave it ~~and~~ my body to the earth to be buried in a decent christianlike manner And as touching such worldly estate as it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life I give and bequeath in manner & form following (to wit)

Item, It is my will and desire that all my property both real and personal be kept together until my wife youngest ~~child~~ shall come of age and then to be equally divided between my wife Sarah Crews and James Stare and my wife's youngest son Samuel Chyet — to them & their heirs forever

Item I give & bequeath unto John Dees all the cattle among my stock that are in his mark and their future increase to him & his heirs forever he to receive them at the direction

of my executor hereafter named. Item, I also order and desire that all the cattle in Samuel Cleyet mark and their future increase be taken out of my estate before a division takes place & delivered to the said Samuel Cleyet for his use and his heirs forever to be delivered at the discretion of my executor.

Item. It is my will and desire that all my just debts be paid and I also make and ordain my worthy friends, Sarah Crew, Thomas Wilder and Elias Warren and James Michael executors and administrators of this my last will and testament in witness whereof I the said John Crew have to this my last will and testament set my hand and seal the day & year above written signed, sealed, published and declared by the said John Crew the testator as his last will and testament in presence of us who were present at the time of signing & sealing thereof
