Executors Administrators and Assigns for ever, but it is my Will  
and desire that the said Negroes and Stock of Cattle, shall not be  
divided until my Said Son Charles Francis Walker shall arrive  
at the Age of Twenty One years or Married, Item I give and be-  
-queath unto my dear and beloved Wife Mary Walker, all and  
singular my Household Goods, Furniture, Stock of Hogs, Sheep, Planta-  
-tion Tools, and Utencils, whatsoever, to her, her Heirs Executors and Assigns  
for ever, The Rest and Residue of my Estate, Real and personal, where-  
-sover situated, I leave and bequeath the same to my Executrix, to be  
disposed off in such Way and Manner, and on such Terms and Con-  
-ditions as she shall think most beneficial and advantagious, and the  
monies arising therefrom after discharging all my just Debts, and  
other necessary expences, to be equally divided between my beloved  
Wife Mary Walker, and my beloved Son Charles Francis Walker
