approaching dissolution from frequent bleeding at my stomach
being perfectly collected I have thought fit to make this my
last will & testament to wit I give and bequeath unto my sister
Susanna Girardine the upper or southwestwardly part of Cedar
grove tract a line to divide the same to begin at the second angle
of the canal dam (leaving the little swamp as designated on the
plat in the lower or Northeastwardly part) and running E. 80°
until it intersects the division line between the tract now called
Bailes and cedar grove. I also give and bequeath unto her
two negroes by name Cappius & Lizzy with seven cows & calves and the
same mare called Ceilipso with all their increase to her and her heirs
forever —

It is my will that two thirds of the undivided tract of land near
Sunbury held by me commonly known by the Distillery land and
called by me Rush brook be divided into three equal parts as
soon as may be convenient and that my affectionate wife Eliz:
abeth Mary Ann Girardine to have choice of one of such divi:
sions together with the Northeastwardly part of cedar grove tract
with all my remaining negroes and stock of horses and cattle sheep
hogs &c to her and her heirs forever, except old Frank who is to
be set free on the day of his marriage and give him his tools
with a cow and calf. — The other two divisions of Rush brook
to be decided by lot between my two sisters one of them to be:
long to my sister Susannah and the other to my sister Eliza:
beth Maybank together with the fort lot I bought from Pomroy
to them & their heirs forever — And I do hereby appoint my
brother in law Dr. John J. L. S. to sell all my lands &
my debts and left all my mortgages, and after the mortgage of
the property I have with John Conner is paid off it shall be dispe:
nsed in the following manner and to wit Tom Dandy Abram
Solomon Jain and old Frank be the property of my sister Eliza:
beth Maybank and her heirs forever, and that Dick
Paul Simah Savry and Rose be the property of my sister Su:
sannah and her heirs forever; and that Harry Nancy July Anna
Clara Alphonse and a young child of Nancy's together with
their labor & issue be the property of Doctor Jain & his sons
no children than and as Harry Ann Girardine

and to the survivor in the case of the death of either before their attaining the age of twenty one years, but if both should die then and in that case all such property together with their increase I give and bequeath to any two sisters Elizabeth Maybank and Susanna Girardeau to be equally divided between them share and share alike, but if both or either of the children should leave lawful issue before they attain to the age of twenty one years in that case such issue to inherit the property vested in the parent; and that my will should not be so construed as to suffer their father or his heirs or heirs to inherit the said property or any part of it if the children should die at any age, and I do hereby appoint Andrew Maybank John Jones and Joseph Jones agents to put that part of my will which respects the two children in force, and they have full power to take the property out of the hands of Samuel Jacob Axson whenever a majority of them shall think proper, and if one of them should die the remaining two shall appoint a third so that the two children may always have three agents and Guardians; and it is my will that Mr Andrew Maybank shall sell the following property for the use benefit of the heirs, subject to the same restrictions as heretofore mentioned & it is also my will that he himself to have no share in any of my property whatever in no case viz the plantation called pinch gut bought of Stephen Williams one thousand and acres of land on the Desert, one thousand acres of land in Glynn county known by the name of Doctors Town and an Island in the Altamaha river containing two hundred and fifty acres.
