Georgia In the name of God, Amen.
Liberty County, I, John Lawson, Senior, of the State and
County aforesaid, being of sound Mind and Memory,
Knowing it is appointed for all men once to Die, I
commit my Soul to the God of my Life through Jesus
Christ my only Redeemer & Saviour and my Body
to the God of the Spirit of all Flesh, I Trust with Him to
Raise up to glory, where Soul and Body shall be

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willed in glory, with their great Head forever to reign
with him to all Eternity. I, Do make, publish and declare
this my last will and Testament, hereby Disannulling
all former Wills by me heretofore made and done and
acknowledging this to be my only Just and true will -
I Recommend my Body to the Earth, to be Buried in a
plain, decent, Christian like manner at the discretion
of my Executors to be hereafter named. And as touching
such worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God to
bless me in this Life, I Give, Devise and dispose
of the same in the manner and form following
To wit. It is my will that all my Just and
Lawful Debts be paid to the satisfaction of my
Creditors. Item I give and bequeath unto Elizabeth
my dearly beloved wife the House and Lot, Number
one hundred and thirty wherein I now live, together
with all and singular the Movable & Personal
things unto belonging, by her to be occupied during
the Term of her Natural Life, provided she continue
in my Name, together with such Furniture as is
hereafter mentioned Viz. Two Dining Tables, one square
table, one side board Table, two small square
painted pine tables, one large Cyprus Ironing table,
some common chairs, one Cherry tree bedstead with
curtains & sackling bottom compasses. One Feather Bed,
with a shifting of new kind of bed cloaths. One mattress
& pair of Sheets therewith, four Silver Table spoons,
the whole of the above Articles being now in use; with
all my Kitchen Furniture of which I am possessed at
this time. Also one Negroe Girl named Suckey. One
black & white Cow and her Calf. And I further give
unto her as her full proportion of my Estate and

In full of all right of burial, which she may claim,
 Then I give and bequeath unto my wife beloved Son John Lawson, Two
 Hundred pounds, to be raised & Levied out of my Estate, also
 my new Book Case and all my Books, only my wife is to have
 the use of such as she chooses; And unto my Grand Children;
 John Lawson, I give & Bequeath as follows unto, Elizabeth &
 John Twenty pounds each, and unto William & Francis, Ten
 pounds each, to be raised in like manner, Then I give
 and Bequeath unto my two Grand Sons, George Chalmer's
 Sonarsall, and John Sonarsall as follows, unto George
 Twenty pounds to be raised out of my Estate, and unto
 John One hundred and fifty pounds, to be put out at
 Interest, or layed out in Negroes, and shall seem most for
 his Interest, by my Executors, the Interest money to be
 used for his support, and the principle to be paid him
 when he shall arrive at the Age of Twenty one Years
 Then I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Harriet
 Bracoch, One hundred and fifty pounds, to be raised &
 Levied out of my Estate, And unto my Grand Daughter
 Ann Bracoch I give Twenty pounds, To John Thomas &
 Anne Bracoch I give ten pounds each, Then I give and
 bequeath unto my Daughter Esther Alexander, One
 Hundred pounds to be raised and Levied in the same man-
 ner as before mentioned, Then I give unto Elizabeth &
 John Milne Twenty five pounds, to be equally divided
 between them; I also draw every part or portion of my
 property belonging to my Estate, that is not particularly
 bequeathed in this will to be sold to the highest bidder -

my Lawful Executor of this my last will and Testament
wholly disannulling, revoking and disallowing all and
any other former Testaments, Wills, Legacies, Bequests
& Executors by me made or done, Vratifying this and no
other to be my last will and Testament

sound Mind and Memory and knowing that it is appointed
for all men once to die, do make this my last will and
Testament: first of all recommending my soul to God who
gave it, and my body to be buried decently at the ministry
of my Church, and with respect to my worldly estate
and effects, with which God hath blessed me in this life, I
bequeath and dispose of them in Manner and form following
First it is my will that all my lawful debts and
Funeral charges be paid out of my Estate
I bequeath to my beloved wife Rebecca Quarterson
in Lieu of what she may be entitled by Law to receive
out of my Estate, my Rising Chair and bay Chair Horse,
