Will and Testament in manner and form following,
That is to say, First, I Will and absolutely Give that all my
Lawful Debt and other Charges be paid and discharged
by my Executors or Executrix hereafter named, Item
it is my Will and positive order that my Tract of Land
black Creek a Branch of the Saltwater be sold, and the
Money arising therefrom to be applied towards discharging
my Debt. Item it is my Will and Intent that my
Loving Wife Mary, Robert should enjoy the Use of my
estate property & the yearly Income arising therefrom
During the Term of her Widowhood, leaving the Main
-tenance of our Children intirely to her discretion
and generosity during that Term of time, and after
Her Marriage or death my Will is and I do hereby
give and Bequeath unto my worthy Children the
whole of my Estate wheresoever or of whatsoever
Nature, to be Equally divided amongst them Share

and there alike are to be rehearsed to them withing annis
at twenty one years, or when married, but if any of them should
arrive at the age of twenty one or marry during the widow-
hood of my wife, then and in that case it is my desire that
the said execution be put off till her death or marriage —
unless it shall be her desire to let them have it, lastly
I do constitute, nominate, my good friend, John Lombert, &
my Eldest son, John Roberts, as soon as he arrives to the
age of twenty one, Executors, and my loving wife Mary
Roberts Executrix, to this my last will and Testament.
