I hereby, I commend soul into the hands of almighty God

state that it has pleased God to bless me with, I dis-
pose thereof as follows, first, it is my will that all
my just debts shall well & truly be paid as soon
as it can conveniently be done. Item I give & be-
queath unto my eldest son Joseph Lockerman
all that tract of land lying on the West branch
of Newport Swamp which I have from my
fathers estate. Item I give & bequeath all that
tract of land I live on including the part I am
entitled too from the estate of Robert Lockerman
as well as the tract of land lying between the
