weak in body but of sound disposing mind and memory
calling to mind that it is appointed for all men once to
die. Do make this my last will & testament in manner
and form following viz after paying my just debts
and funeral charges I give and bequeath to my nephew
Daniel Baker all my stock of cattle together with all
such money as I may be possessed of at the time of my
death or may be owing to me the cattle to be kept for him
and the money to be laid out for his use at the discretion
of my executor hereafter named, I give and bequeath to my
niece Sarah Baker wife of my nephew William Baker one
feather bed one mattress bolster pillows blankets and two bed
quilts. I give & bequeath to my niece Rebecca Baker and
my niece Hannah Bricevelt all my wearing apparel to be
equally divided between them & Lastly I constitute and
appoint my nephew William Baker and my friend John
Mell executors to this my last will. ~~Witness~~ with full
power to see it executed in witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand & seal the day of April
one thousand eight hundred & three
