Do make this my last will & testament in manner and form following viz after paying my just debts and funeral charges I give and bequeath to my nephew Daniel Baker all my stock of cattle together with all such money as I may be possessed of at the time of my death or may be owing to me the cattle to kept for him

and the money to be laid out for his use at the direction of my executors hereafter named. I give and bequeath to my niece Sarah Baker wife of my nephew William Baker one feather bed one matraps bolster pillows blankets and two bed quilts. I give & bequeath to my niece Rebecca Baker and my niece Hannah Bradwell all my wearing apparel to be equally divided between them. Lastly I constitute and appoint my nephew William Baker and my friend John McCall executors to this my last will ~~etc etc~~ with full power to see it executed in every thing which I have herunto set my hand & seal the day of April one thousand eight hundred & three
