 Rebecca Bennett of the State, and County aforesaid, being weak
 of body, but of perfect mind, and memory, and calling to
 mind my mortality, do make, and appoint this my last
 Will, and Testament, in manner, and form following, that
 is to say, Inprimis, committing my Soul in the hands of God—
 my faithful Creator, and glorious Redeemer, and my body
 to the dust to be buried at the discretion of my Executors,
 nothing doubting, but I shall receive the same again by
 the mighty power of God in the resurrection. My will is that
 my lawful debts, and funeral charges be paid, Item I give
 and bequeath to Hugh Bennett son of Matthew Bennett, and
 Rebecca Robertson, daughter of Christian Robertson, two Mares
 and their followers, five heads of cattle, and hogs to be divided
 between them, I give, and bequeath to Hugh McCullough
 son of James McCullough a negro girl named Pley, and
 one boy July; The rest of my Estate both real, and personal
 I give, and bequeath to Mary, and William Flemming,
 Mary is not to take her part till William is twenty
 years of age, if William should die under age Mary gets the
 whole, if he live till twenty years William gets the whole
 Lastly I constitute, ordain, and appoint John Whitehead
 and James McCullough Executors of this my last Will,
 and Testament, and Legacies whatever by me heretofore made
 and done, ratifying, and confirming this, and none.
