Mitchell Junr and Charles Irvine executors of my
beloved Wife Sarah Baker Executrix to this my
last will & Testament, Disannulling all other Wills hitherto
made by me — Witness my Hand & Seal this Fifth Day of
April one thousand Seven hundred & Ninety two,

In the Name of God Amen. I Rebecca
Quarterman of the County of Liberty and State of Georgia
being in health of Body and of Sound Mind and Mem-
ory, calling to Mind my Mortality, and knowing
that it is Appointed for all men once to Die, Do make
and Appoint this my last Will and Testament, in manner
and form following, committing my Body to the Earth to
be buried with a decent and Christian like Burial as
the Discretion of my Executors, and my Soul unto the Lord in
the Name of the Father Amen

I Will that at my Lawfull Ditts and Funerals charge
be paid. — I give my Children Rebecca, Junson, Samuel
Jons, Sarah Baptist, William Ball, Sampson Edward
Ball, Susannah Quarterman, & Robert Quarterman
One Shilling each, to be paid them when of Age
I Give the Residue of my Estate, Real, & Personal

to the Child or Children of which I am now pregnant, to be
Delivered to them when arrived to Age by Law, or at Mar-
riage. But in case one of them dies in Minority, it is
my Will the Other shall have its part. And in case that
this also under Age, It is my Will the said Estate shall
be made into Three parts, Two of those parts to be divided
equally among my Three Children Rebecca Quarmen
Samuel Jones, and Sarah Capell, to them, their heirs
Assigns forever. The other remaining third part to be
divided among my other Children, namely William
Ball, Sampson Edwards Ball, Susannah Quarter-
man, and Robert Quarman to them, their heirs &
Assigns forever, — I constitute and appoint my
Brother William Parker, my son in law Joseph
Quarman, & my son Samuel Jones, & William Ball
Executors of this my last Will and Testament, and
authorize and empower them to Buy and Sell as a
Majority of them shall Judge for the Advantage of
my Estate, without being liable to suffer Damages
on Account of any loss that may happen thereby
And I do hereby revoke and make void all former
Wills by me hitherto made Declaring, ratifying &
Confirming this, and no other to be my last Will &
Testament, In Witness whereof, I have hereunto set my
Hand and seal this second Day of December in the year
of our Lord 1793
