I Robert Sallett of Liberty County and State of Georgia
Planter being weak in Body, but of perfect and disposing
Mind and Memory, calling to mind the Mortality of
my Body, do make and Ordain this my last will and
Testament in manner following. viz. all my Real
Estate, together with my four Riding Horses, the
Hambler, blue skin, Dove and Jack of Diamonds and
all my Stock of Hogs and Goats must be sold in
order to pay my Debts, as far as the Money arising
therefrom will go. My will is that all my Slaves
except Milly and Muff shall be left in the Care of
Mr Simon Fraser, allowing him full power to
Improve my Estate for the Benefit of my Son.

all my moveable goods of value by bequeathing them or otherwise
 as he shall think proper. Item, my will is that all
 my stock of Cattle shall be left to the Care of my Trusty
 Friend Jonathan Bacon, to have them butchered and sold
 that the Money arising therefrom may pay my Debts
 as far as it will go. Item - my will is that my
 beloved Friend Nathan Taylor shall have the whole
 management and bringing up my son, Item my
 will is that if any son should die before he arrives at
 the above mentioned seventeen Years, that all my Estate
 shall be equally divided amongst my Sister and Children
 Item, I also leave with my Friend Nathan Taylor all
 my household goods and chattels together with my two
 Silver mounted Guns and the above Lilly and Mary
 In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
 and Seal the day and Year above written
